

Admission to B. Pharmacy & B.Sc (Hons.) under N.R.I./Foreign Nationals Category Seats at Panjab University Chandigarh

1. 9th Aug. 2019 is the last date to apply for available vacant B.Pharmacy & B.Sc (Hons) for NRI/Foreign National Category Seats.
Admission Form should reach by **9th Aug. 2019 4:00 p.m. at the Office of Dean International Students, Panjab University, Sector-14, Chandigarh- 160 014 (dis@pu.ac.in)**
2. Form is available at <https://cetug.puchd.ac.in>. Candidate is required to take printout and fill the form in complete respect.
3. Only Offline Form is required to be submitted by the candidate for claiming the NRI/Foreign National category seat.
4. In case of NRI sponsor, an Affidavit from the NRI sponsor (available at <https://cetug.puchd.ac.in>) and copy of his/her passport is required along with the Form. An Affidavit from the candidate regarding his/her relationship with the NRI sponsor (available at <https://cetug.puchd.ac.in>) is also required.
5. **The counseling will be held on 10th Sept., 2019 in the Auditorium of Department of Physics, Panjab University.**

Important Pointer - Seats available as Wards of NRIs (Excerpt taken from Handbook of Information-2019 Page 15 -16)

A student who seeks admission as a ward of Foreign National or Non-Resident Indian should be in a first degree/blood relationship with foreign national or Non-resident Indian. The term first degree/blood relationship includes

- (a) spouse
- (b) children (natural/adopted/foster)
- (c) real brother and sister of father, i.e., real uncle and real aunt.
- (d) real brother and sister of mother, i.e., real maternal uncle and maternal aunt
- (e) father and mother of father, i.e., grand-father and grand-mother
- (f) father and mother of mother, i.e., maternal grand-father and maternal grand-mother
- (g) first degree-paternal and maternal cousins.

Note:

- (i) A candidate once admitted as NRI candidate in an undergraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI for subsequent admission to any course at Panjab University.

(ii) Candidates who take admission under NRI quota and are promoted from undergraduate to postgraduate course in Hons. School framework (ongoing program) shall not be allowed to change their category.

Admission on the basis of CET-UG held by Panjab University, in case the candidate has done 10+2 from India; otherwise see conditions in Handbook of Information-2019 Page 15 -16.

For consideration under the NRI category, the candidate has to fill the application form and provide an affidavit from the Non-Resident Indian (in case of NRI sponsor) who is in first degree/blood relationship with the applicant.

Last date for filling Application form: 9th Sept., 2019.

For the candidates with 10+2 from India, they must have qualified CET-UG examination conducted by Panjab University. Those NRI candidates shall compete amongst themselves for admission to various courses. Their inter-se merit shall be determined on bases of the score obtained in SAT-II, GRE, GMAT etc. In case of Foreign Nationals (non-English speaking states), TOEFL/IELTS score should also be produced.
